

Eaton sets timeline for transition to industrial gateway network management cards for UPS

To keep pace with the global information technology landscape, Eaton is announcing the intent to transition from its existing line of Power Xpert gateway UPS management cards to more advanced industrial gateway cards. Both of Eaton's industrial gateway cards bring a host of improvements including gigabit network speeds as well as UL 2900-1 and IEC 62443-4-2 certification for cybersecurity.

- The [Eaton Power Xpert Gateway X-Slot UPS Card](#) (P/N: PXGXUPS) will become EOL effective Dec. 31, 2021 and will be replaced by the Eaton Industrial Gateway X-Slot Card (P/N: INDGW-X2), which launches later this year.
- The [Eaton Power Xpert Gateway UPS Mini-Slot Card](#) (P/N: PXGMSUPS) will become EOL effective Mar. 31, 2022 and will be replaced by the [Eaton Industrial Gateway Mini-Slot Card](#) (P/N: INDGW-M2).

Due to a rapid increase in cybersecurity requirements in the industry, Eaton is encouraging all customers who standardize on the current Power Xpert gateway cards to migrate to the appropriate Eaton industrial gateway card as soon as possible.
